SUMMARY

I graduated from AUT in 1997, having completed a Bachelor of Communication Studies. Since then my work has primarily been in the television and film industries, concentrating on production coordination and management. My roles have also included assistant directing, writing, researching and location coordination.

After graduation I worked for the NZ Writers Guild as their Executive Assistant, a position I held for two years. My responsibilities included all membership matters, production of a monthly magazine, coordination of seminars and courses plus any other administrative work that was required.

At the same time I also worked for Coalface Productions as a general dogs-body, working on both *Inside New Zealand* and *Documentary New Zealand* programmes. Titles include *Building Dreams*, *Hell for Leather*, *B is for Bullying*, *Sweet As* and *The Breakfast Club*.

In 1998 I accepted the role of PA to the Executive Officer of the (then) Academy of Film and TV Arts. I assisted in the running of three Film and Television Awards Ceremonies which were broadcast live from the Auckland Town Hall. I was responsible for coordinating the entries and assisting with the stage and post-awards dinner arrangements for about 800 guests.

Late 1999 I made a switch into drama production work. Projects included feature films *Crooked Earth, Vertical Limit, Ozzie* and *Her Majesty* and the mini-series *Superfire*. This work was varied and demanding and gave me a solid grounding in being able to organise and prioritise large projects. It also taught me the importance of flexibility when approaching different tasks.

In 2001 I focused on production management and coordination of TV commercials, short films and documentaries. In 2002 I was contracted as Assistant Production Manager of the Thailand Unit on a big budget US film called *Beyond Borders*. This was a very challenging role as we had upwards of 700 people to manage in a very unpredictable and dynamic environment. Still got it sorted though!

During 2002 and 2003 I contracted to Drum Productions as Production Manager for the live outside broadcast of *Style Pasifika* – then held at the Auckland Town Hall. My role included managing the crew, gear, volunteers and helping with the on-the-night logistics of the show.

Since the end of 2003 I have worked on a great variety of short-term contract projects as a Production Coordinator, Production Manager and Assistant Director, working both locally and overseas. These have included feature films, television drama and big budget commercials. I have become proficient at working in a way that requires different skill sets and dynamics. It has made me very adaptable and open to the best way to approach a project and complete it successfully.

In 2011 I spent six months working on a documentary as a Project Manager for Oceanic Nature Film Productions. This included the logistics and support of not only a documentary film crew but 7 x sailing crews as they sailed around the Pacific Islands on a voyage called *Te Mana O Te Moana*. I coordinated around 140 crew-members at any one time and organised their requirements on land – travel, visas, repairs, provisioning, events and accommodation.

In 2014 I spent six months Production Managing *Real Pasifik Series 2* for Zoomslide Media and then stayed on with the company as a full-time Producer/Production Manager for 2yrs with them.

I am currently back freelancing producing and production managing TVC's, stills and on-line content.
